We know healthcare is one of your top concerns and that's why RVH is planning for the future; a future which includes determining how to best use the space still available within the current Georgian Drive facility, and planning for a new, state-of-the-art south campus.

Master Programming

RVH's long-range planning exercise is more than half-way complete and exciting details about the future are emerging.

There are currently three planning phases underway:

1. Site selection for the future south campus in Innisfil or south Barrie
2. Master Programming to determine future services
3. Master Planning to determine space and facility needs

What exactly is Master Programming?

Put simply, Master Programming will define RVH's long-term service model. We look at:

- **What** services will be provided?
- **How** will they be delivered?
- **Where** will the services be provided (north campus, south campus or in the community)?

Master Programming is determined through population projections, data analysis and ongoing community engagement.

"This planning exercise is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity which will impact North Simcoe Muskoka residents' access to healthcare for generations to come," notes RVH president and CEO Janice Skot. "We need to get this right. That's why our planning and engagement process is so comprehensive and transparent."

Through broad consultation with 1,000 members of TEAM RVH, along with almost 14,000 interactions with the community, we are planning for redeveloped services, expanded services, new services and new ways of delivering care — all to better meet the needs of our patients and families.

Site selection progress

RVH's Site Selection Committee has assessed almost 50 potential sites and compared them using clear, weighted criteria and over 2,000 data points.

Through a fair, transparent process, the committee has now narrowed its search to the nine highest-ranking sites.

Broad community consultation has also helped refine the search. We received thoughtful insights from thousands of area residents, TEAM RVH and our community partners, who responded to surveys and participated in focus group discussions. You told us it's important to consider:



- Road access to site, particularly from Highway 400
- Multiple road access points to the site
- Ability to service the site quickly
- Future planned public transportation
- Alignment with existing and planned development
- Impact on existing surrounding community

Next steps will be to continue to assess the sites and narrow down the options to at least two highest-ranked locations. In the meantime, we will continue to talk to our communities through surveys, presentations, social media and focus groups. RVH wants your input!
